Paris: 3h by train

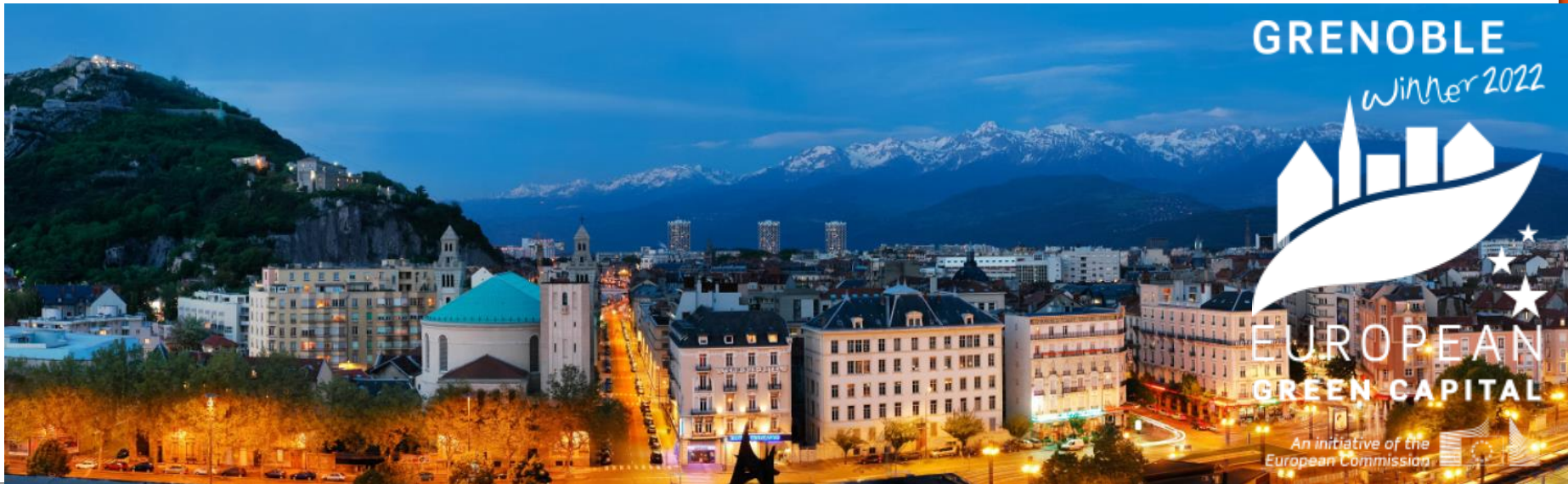

GRENOBLE: Exceptional Scientific Environment

- International laboratories and instruments
 - ▶ For exemple the European Synchrotron Radiation Facility (3rd biggest in the world)
- 9 National research organizations
 - ▶ CNRS, CEA, Inria, Inserm, Irstea, INRAE, CRSSA, IRD, CEN, CNR
- Major companies' headquarters
 - ▶ Hewlett Packard, Sun Microsystems, Orange, STMicroelectronics, Schneider Electric, General Electric (ex Alstom), Xerox, Thales...



In 2020, a big international campus was created including a school of architecture, a school of political sciences and Grenoble INP-UGA within the University of Grenoble Alpes, totaling 60 000 students.

University of Grenoble Alpes is **one of the 8 French** universities labeled IDEX (initiative of excellence).

Grenoble INP-UGA Engineering schools is a “Grande Ecole”

But what does this mean??

An original feature of the French system of higher education in science and technology is that there are in fact two parallel systems: the universities, and the Grandes Ecoles d’Ingénieurs that train highly selected students to occupy key positions as engineer-managers.

The main features of a Grande Ecole are :

- highly selective admissions procedures ;
- courses that match the requirements of industry and business;
- a very good staff-student ratio

GET AROUND !

In Grenoble, a travel pass for the "TAG" transport network and the "Mvélo+" bike rental service vary in price according to age:

From €15 a month for the under 24s to €60 a month for the "TAG" transportation service

€15 to €25 a month for a "Mvélo+" bike rental.
