

Requirement for your Learning Agreement

Politecnico di Torino Governing Board established that you have to define a proposal of Learning Agreement including at least 18 credits/ECTS per semester from the Degree Course of application.

This decision involves only the selection of courses; final project credits are excluded from the requirement of having in the Learning Agreement 18 credits of the main Degree Course.

As you are invited to attend at PoliTo 20/30 credits per semester, there is still the possibility to choose some courses from other majors than the one of application. The remaining courses can be selected from the study plans of both Bachelor and Master of Science.

*the B1 and B2 levels refer to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages

The level of English has to be declared by the Home University during the student's nomination. This declaration is enough to fulfill the language requirements
