Blended Intensive Programme Barcelona to Grenoble, 01-07 sept. '24

The U!Train is an intensive blended study program aiming at uniting 2 partner universities through a train journey, between Barcelona and Grenoble, this year. Alliance for a unique experience that combined academic work with socialising activities, all while advocating for sustainable travel. 
