Brief Description

The Master of Arts Geschichte (i.e. History) programme enables students to specialise in a specific area, to participate in up-to-date research projects and offers the opportunity for acquiring teaching skills as student tutors. The compulsory internship in a relevant field gives the student practical experience to lay the groundwork for a post-university career.

A semester abroad is not mandatory but nevertheless strongly recommended and is ideally integrated into the third semester.
