

Funding for 2022



Thomas Weiland Stiftung

For the year 2022, the Thomas Weiland Foundation will be awarding

16 scholarships for bachelor's and master's students.

The funding will be provided beginning 1st April 2022 (summer semester) and 1st October 2022 (winter semester), respectively.

Applications are to be filed electronically (as PDF) to the board of the Thomas Weiland Foundation (kontakt@tws.tu-darmstadt.de).

Application deadlines

31st December 2021 (if beginning a bachelor's or master's degree course in summer semester 2022)

30th June 2022 (if beginning a master's degree course in winter semester 2022/23)

1. Requirements for Funding

Funding will be provided to students who have achieved outstanding results while obtaining their bachelor's degrees and will be beginning a STEM¹-related master's degree course at the Darmstadt University of Technology in the respective semesters (1. subject-related semester).

2. Application Procedure

Students can apply for funding from the Foundation in writing. The following documents must be submitted:

- Letter of application which describes the applicant's education so far, future educational plans, and their significance to the STEM field
- CV and documents showing the applicant's most important school and academic achievements, as well as any contributions to socially worthy projects
- Transcript of all university course marks including applicant's ranking within the course for the year or semester of graduation (statement of ranking usually issued by course or examination office).

The students will be informed whether their application has been approved by mid-March (applications for summer semester) or mid-September (applications for winter semester).

3. How Funding is Provided

Funding is provided as a **scholarship over the course of six (Bachelor) or four (Master) semesters**. In this period, recipients will be awarded an amount of

750 euro per month.

Only students who are enrolled at the Darmstadt University of Technology while receiving funding are eligible. This means that students are eligible if they are already enrolled at the Darmstadt University of Technology or if they are enrolled at another university but planning to begin a master's course at the University in Darmstadt.

Students who exmatriculate will no longer receive funding. In addition, students are to inform the Foundation of their academic progress each semester. If recipients fail to make progress according to their degree course scheme without having a good reason, the Trustees may terminate funding.

4. Funding Approval

The Advisory Council of the Thomas Weiland Foundation are responsible for approving funding applications based on the Foundation's funding guidelines.
