#### Security through permanent contracts


Permanent tasks need to be taken over by employees with permanent contracts. But in administrational and technical positions, around 16% off staff have fixedterm contracts - twice as many as in other sectors. With 93% fixed-term contracts among scientists, the TU sadly is the frontrunner in Hessen. The new collective bargaining agreement of ver.di offers possibilities, to create more permanent perspectives after Ph.D. All need a secure future!

#### More autonomy at work

With a clear focus on the needs of employees, we influence working conditions, for example with negotiations on desksharing, working hours, etc.

## **Integration instead of Outsourcing**

The cleaning staff has to be directly employed at the TU again! This would improve their working conditions and the quality of cleaning. We are one workforce!

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#### **Our Balance Sheet**

In the last three years, the Offene Liste ver.di has significantly influenced the work of the Staff Council. Our members have taken part in all major working groups. To name some of them: AG Reintegration Management (BEM), AG Working Times, AG Desksharing, AG Kodex Good Work and AG Mobile Work, which we successfully concluded last year.

We significantly advanced the paper of the Staff Council ImPuls. We took part in countless job interviews, controlled even more recruiting and wage (Eingruppierung) processes and corrected unfair practices.

We were the driving force in all legal clarifications and were successful in all of these conflicts: We secured the right of the Staff Council to inform all employees via email, the right of Codetermination concerning Desksharing und the payment of colleagues in Marie-Skłodowska-Curie-Actions.

We strongly supported trade union activities and initiatives like the TVStud, darmstadt unbefristet and DGB-Hochschulgruppe, TUtalausfall verhindern!

At the same time, we had very constructive cooperation in the Staff Council across all status groups and lists.

#### Take part

ver.di-members in the Staff Council (Personalrat) are also ver.di shop stewards (ver.di-Vertrauensleute) and take part in our regular meetings.
